Our experience with dual degree study programs : our success story (1)

- MBA/MF International Finance and Banking 8 groups (121 graduand)
- BBA International Management/ Bachelor of Finance 2 groups
- -High demand during economic boom and crisis
- -English as working language: unlimited study sources
- -2 different diplomas (not certificates!)
- -Top level professors: both practical and academic experience -FLEX MBA vs Full time
- -Global context and international professors
- -Value of diplomas 2 schools: accreditations, marketing
- campaigns, libraries, projects
- -International exchange
- -Languages as many as possible



Our experience with dual degree study programs : our success story (2)

MBA/MF International Finance and Banking – 8 groups (121 graduand)

~96% graduate (MBA/MF) 100% employment ~80% fast promotion at work ~20% rocket career in a year ~20% start own business (even parallel to constant employment) ~15% start to invest on markets



Our experience with dual degree study programs : main success factors

- Perfect reputation: program, school, country
- High quality of studies: no compromise
- Student = client: services level
- FLEX type of studies: working students
- Good Program Manager
- Reliable partner: minimum changes in schedule
- Support from employers: all kind
- Alumni club: networking
- State school + private school = good tandem



Our experience with dual degree study programs : challenges
