Generalist or specialist MBA 2014




Preferred MBA delivery 2010/2014






Why are you planning to study for an MBA? (select up to two options)










Thinking more broadly about an ideal MBA program, what are the five most important aspects for you?








When making a decision about which MSc to study, what is most important?




