The Eduniversal International Scientific Committee

Back in October 2007, when the International Scientific Committee, composed of 9 independent experts and 2 representatives of the Eduniversal Group, met for the first time in Paris to publish the 1000 Best Business Schools ranking. After months of research and many hours of deliberations, the official selection was made up of schools from a total of 154 countries.



AFRICA Prof. Sherif Kamel

Sherif Kamel is professor of management and vice president for information management at the American University in Cairo (2015-present). He was founding dean of the School of Business (2009-2014). Kamel led a major repositioning of the school by adopting a multi-tier thematic approach that included entrepreneurship, innovation, leadership and responsible business. In 2014, he successfully led the school to AACSB, EQUIS, AMBA and ACCET accreditations joining 70 business school in the world that are known as triple-crown accredited. In addition, he helped establish the Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation and the university's Venture Lab becoming Egypt's primary university-based incubator. He was associate dean for executive education (2008-2009), and director of the Management Center (2002-2008). Before joining AUC, he was director of the Regional IT Institute (1992-2001) and managed the training department of the Cabinet of Egypt Information and Decision Support Center (1989-1992). He is a member of the AACSB International Middle East Advisory Council (2015-present); and the Egypt-US Business Council (2013-present). He was executive VP of the American Chamber of Commerce in Egypt (2012-2015) and member in the World Bank Knowledge Advisory Commission (2012-2014). He holds a PhD in information systems from London School of Economics and Political Science (1994), an MBA (1990) and a BA in business administration (1987) and an MA in Islamic art and architecture (2013) from the American University in Cairo.



EURASIA & MIDDLE-EAST Prof. Nehme Azoury

Nehme Azoury is a Professor and Deputy-President for research at the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik – USEK. He is also one of the eight members of the scientific committee of Eduniversal (the representative of the Eurasian region). Former Dean of the Faculty of Business, he lectures in the fields of marketing, strategy and Corporate Governance in several reputed universities namely, The Georges Washington University, which presented him with an appreciation award. As part of his research activities, he has to his credit several publications in internationally renowned scientific journals. He also serves as a Board member of Lithuanian Free Market Institute, VilNews on-line magazine, and number of other institutions. Dr. Virginijus Kundrotas is Founding President of ISM University of Management and Economics, Lithuania (first private HEI in the country) performed in this position from year of establishment in 1999 till 2008. Dr. George Jabbour is the Associate Dean for Executive Education, Professor of Finance, and Director of the Masters in Finance Program at The George Washington University School of Business. He has been a consultant and conducting professional training for the World Bank Group in Washington DC (USA), Vienna (Austria) and Islamabad (Pakistan), for The International Training Banking Center in Budapest (Hungary), the Center of Excellence in Management in Kuwait, and for Kipco Asset Management Group (KAMCO) in Kuwait. He was a Visiting Professor at Franklin College in Lugano (Switzerland), Dongseo University (South Korea), Holy Spirit University-Kaslik, Sorbonne University in Paris (France) and Renmin University in Beijing (China). He developed curriculum for BBA and Msc degrees in business and finance. He has several publications in professional refereed journals. He co-authored "The Option Trader Handbook" for trade adjustments. His research papers were presented in the US and around the world. He is a member of several leading professional finance organizations. He is a member of the editorial advisory board of five journals. Four of his co-authored papers won the best paper award. He has received several Teaching Excellence Awards. In addition to his academic career, Dr. Jabbour is very active in equity and derivatives trading. The Eduniversal Evaluation System (EES)

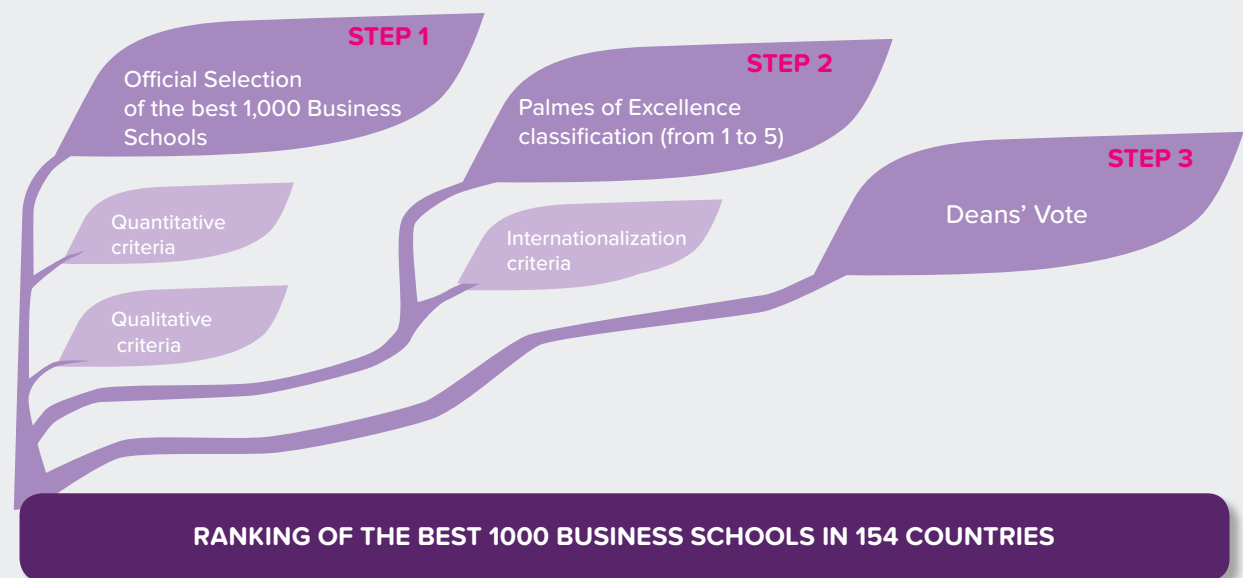
The **Eduniversal Evaluation System (EES)** assess two international rankings, each with their own methodology: the top 1000 global business schools and the top 4000 Masters and MBA programmes, both from 154 countries across 9 geographical zones.

The EES, created under the guidance of the International Scientific Committee (ISC), is comprised of nine independent experts from each geographical zone.

1 Methodology of the 1000 Best Business Schools Ranking – A 3-step process



2 The Official Selection of the 1000 Best Business Schools

In 2007 the ISC created the methodology for the Official Selection ranking with the goal of establishing a global mapping system that recognizes an institution's international reputation and influence.

The system gathers data from thousands of schools worldwide and selects the best 1000 business schools to be listed in the ranking. The chosen institutions are then grouped by country. In accordance to their

international influence, reputation and quality, they are later categorised in the Palmes of Excellence league.

Once the Palmes of Excellence classification has been established, the results from the Deans' vote survey will be used to conclude the ranking of each Palmes category.

The ranking recognizes the best business schools in each country framed under their respective Palmes of Excellence category.

The final ranking shows, within each Palme category, the best business schools in each country.

The **Eduuniversal ranking** recognizes the best academic institutions worldwide:

- Africa
- Eurasia and the
- Eastern Europe
- Latin America
- Oceania
- Central Asia
- Middle East
- Far East Asia
- North America
- Western Europe

A quota sample based on qualitative and quantitative criteria is used to determine how many universities can be ranked from each country.

The quantitative criteria:

- National expenditure on education per capita
- The GDP per capita
- Size of the population
- Number of students enrolled in higher education

The qualitative criteria:

- Number of Higher Education institutions in the country
- Historical importance of education at national level.

Evolution of the Eduuniversal Official Selection of the Best Business Schools

Every year the Eduuniversal International Scientific Committee reviews and updates the list of the Best Business Schools accordingly.

Institutions interested in entering the Eduuniversal Official Selection ranking, will need to complete an evaluation form. Participation is free of charge.

Institutions that have not received any votes in the Deans' vote, merged with another academic institution or have closed down will not be considered.

3 Eduniversal Rating : Palmes of Excellence

The Eduniversal system rates schools according to their reputation at a national, regional and international level. Once the 1000 best Business Schools have been selected, they are categorised by country into one of the five Palmes of Excellence leagues.

Eduniversal Evaluation System (EES): a 3-step process used to create the Business School ranking list in each of the 154 countries



There are five levels of Palmes of Excellence leagues. Within each level, schools are defined by a set of internationalisation criteria, developed by the International Scientific Committee. Concluded with the Dean's vote results, the selected institutions are then ranked within their Palmes league.

Internationalisation criteria:

- ▶ Accreditations
- ▶ Major rankings of Business Schools
- ▶ Membership to national and international academic associations

For the purpose of ensuring a fair comparison between each geographical zone, in the Palmes of Excellence league, the schools are rated and ranked by country.

By comparing institutions horizontally, instead of the widely used vertical method, schools are evaluated and assessed at a national level.

The Palme leagues are divided as followed:

100 schools in the 5 Palmes league		Universal Business School with strong global influence
200 schools in the 4 Palmes league		Top Business School with significant international influence
400 schools in the 3 Palmes league		Excellent Business School with reinforcing international influence
200 schools in the 2 Palmes league		Good Business School with strong regional influence
100 schools in the 1 Palme league		Business School with considerable local influence

League changes

Upgrade:

The process to change league is based on:

- **The Dean's vote result:** analysing the survey using the Eduniversal Evaluation System (EES), schools who have scored higher than previous years and have shown continuous improvements in comparison to institutions within their country will be subject to an upgrade.
- **Request to upgrade:** Institutions that have undergone significant changes such as; national and international accreditations, major institutional developments, innovative projects etc, the institution can submit a request by presenting their case to the International Scientific Committee. Using the Palmes of Excellence methodology criteria, the ISC will assess the application.

Downgrade:

If an executive member of the ISC puts forward a downgrade for an institution, the committee will assess the case based on the results from the previous year Dean's vote survey.

Stages of the re-evaluation process:

The request for an upgrade should be sent along with the list of requested documents, to:

international.coordinator@eduniversal.com.

The request will then be reviewed by the appointed ISC member of the institutions geographical zone and the Eduniversal Board of Directors. If approved, the request will then be further reviewed by the rest of the ISC.

The institution will be informed about the decision at the next edition of the **Eduniversal World**

Convention. Should the request be refused, the ISC will explain the grounds of their judgement and provide recommendations for future candidacy.

The reevaluation process is free of charge.

4 Eduniversal Ranking : Dean's Vote

The Dean's vote is the final metric used to determine an institution's position in the Palmes league. Institutions featured in the Official Selection are reviewed by peers from the 1,000 best Business Schools. Each institution representative can vote for up to 50% of the listed schools in each country.

One institution counts as one vote, giving the respective Dean or Director the opportunity to vote for the schools located in their geographical zone. The voting procedure is confidential.

The results will also contribute to the Palmes league ranking. The ranking of the top 1000 is updated in accordance with the results from the Dean's vote.

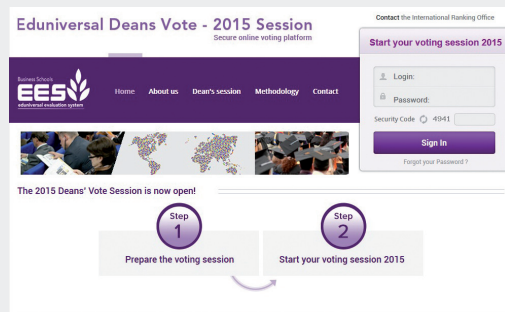

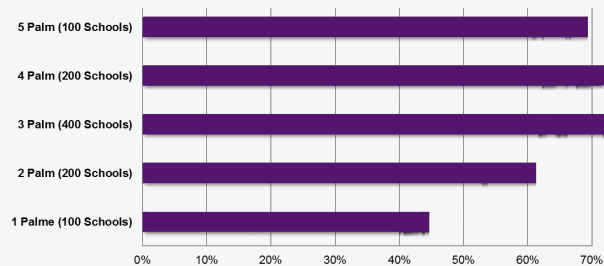
